


Naming Parts of Plants and Animals

How to use the activity

Naming Parts of Plants and Animals is a way children can get to know the names of the main parts of different types of plants and animals by putting parts and labels onto pictures. There are options for:


- * Parts of a Plant
- * Parts of a Tree
- * Parts of a Wilted Plant
- * Parts of a Horse
- * Parts of an Insect



The picture shown on the left side of the screen can be completed by dragging the parts making up the outline (eg petal, stem etc.) from inside the white box on the right and placing them into position on main picture.

Each attempt is recorded for the reporting data. When an item is placed correctly, a correct audio is made, and if not, an error sound is made, and children can try to place it again. Each attempt is recorded for the reporting data.

When all of the objects have been placed, a number of labels will be shown, which can also be dragged onto the picture. When a label is placed, you can click on the speaker icon to hear and read more about the item.

Learning Outcomes

Be able to name the main parts of a flower, tree and animals

Understand the words: leaf, root, petal, stem, bark, trunk

How the activity could be used in the classroom

Lesson ideas, how to obtain the educational outcomes

Ideas for work away from the computer

Children could find and name common plants, flowers and trees, especially those found in the local area

Children could examine different flowers and plants in detail, comparing their leaves, petals etc. (they may need a magnifying glass for this).

Find a tree stump, or a tree trunk or branch that has been cut through, and count the rings on it, which indicates the age of the tree or branch.

Children could sketch different plants and flowers, or trees, or may do leaf or bark rubbing.

Learn about the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees
